

Pay Dates for DC 37 Economic Contract Raises

MAYORAL AGENCIES and Department of Education

September 26th 2014 – Rate only increase 9/3/11, 1% and 9/3/12, 1% (2.01% total) will be applied to base salary for employees who had no status change since 2011 and included in regular paycheck. No changes in level, title, promotion etc. Employees who had a status change will receive their increases on 10/10 as described below.

October 10, 2014 – \$1,000 ratification bonus (pro-rated for part-time employees).

- Included in regular paycheck for employees who had a status change - Rate for 1st and 2nd increases for 9/3/11 – 1% and 9/3/12 – 1% (2.01% total).
- For all employees, whether or not they had a status change, RETRO for 9/3/11, 1% and 9/3/12, 1% including overtime and night shift differential earned during that period.

October 24, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- Rate and retro for the 3rd and 4th increases (including overtime and night shift differential) for 9/3/13 – 1% and 9/3/14 – 1.5%.

November 7th, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- *Recuring Increment Increases (RIP) increases will be processed.*

November 21st, 2014

- Service increment increases for employees who have received the increment for more than two years. Retro and rate increases, if applicable, for 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2014 will be paid in this check.
- Retired, separated or terminated mayoral agency employees will be paid on 10/10 for any retro due for 2011 and 2012, and a second check on 10/24 if due retro for 9/3/2013 or 9/3/2014.
- Employees who left active payroll before August 5th are NOT eligible for ratification bonus.

HEALTH AND HOSPITALS CORPORATION (Includes active and separated employees)

October 10, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- \$1,000 ratification bonus, (pro-rated for part time employees)

October 24, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- Rate and Retro Increases for 9/3/11 – 1%
- 9/3/12 – 1%
- 9/3/13 – 1%
- 9/3/14 – 1.5%

NYC HOUSING AUTHORITY

October 16, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- \$1,000 ratification bonus,
- Rate increases for 2011 and 2012 – active employees only
- 9/3/11 – 1%
- 9/3/12 – 1%

October 30, 2014 – Included in regular paycheck

- All retroactive payments for 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2014
- Rate increases for 2013 and 2014 - active employees only
- 9/3/13 – 1%
- 9/3/14 – 1.5%

November 13, 2014 (NYCHA)

- Retroactive payments for terminated, separated or retired employees for percentage increases only. Employees who left payroll before August 5th are not eligible for the ratification bonus.
