NYCHA MEMBER ALERT

Earlier this year NYCHA, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the City entered into an agreement to address various conditions that affect **WORKERS AND RESIDENTS**.

The agreement included a Federal Monitor to oversee NYCHA which provides for the creation of a Community Advisory Committee including labor. DC 37 is committed to ensuring the long term sustainability of NYCHA housing while protecting jobs, salaries and benefits for our members.

You recently received an email from the Interim Chair and CEO Kathryn Garcia regarding the Monitor interviewing NYCHA employees.

IF YOU ARE CONTACTED BY THE MONITOR OR HIS REPRESENTATIVES PLEASE NOTIFY YOUR UNION REPRESENTATIVE IMMEDIATELY AND ASK TO HAVE A UNION REPRESENTATIVE PRESENT DURING THE QUESTIONS!
