

Citywide Contract - Article V

In accordance with Mayor Adams' announcement on April 11, 2022, Informational includes Juneteenth as a paid New York City holiday.

Section 9.

a. The regular holidays with pay shall be as follows:

New Year's Day	January 1st
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Third Monday in January
Lincoln's Birthday (Floating Holiday)*	February 12,
President's Day	Third Monday in February
Memorial Day	Last Monday In May
Juneteenth	June 19th
Labor Day	First Monday in September
Columbus Day	Second Monday in October
Election Day	First Tuesday following the First Monday In November
Veterans Day	November 11th
Thanksgiving Day	Fourth Thursday in November
Christmas Day	December 25th

*In lieu of Lincoln's Birthday, employees subject to the holiday provisions of the Citywide Agreement or Based on the 2002 MEA (except for unions that opted out of this provision), civilian employees newly hired on or after July 1, 2004 are not eligible for the Floating Holiday, beginning in Calendar Year 2005.
